Donna Bailey obtained her Bachelor of Visual Arts and Master of Visual Arts from La Trobe University and is currently a PhD candidate in the school of Visual arts and Design. She has exhibited widely in Victoria and New South Wales. She has been a finalist or winner of several art prizes, including the National Photographic Purchase Award for the Albury Regional Art Gallery in 2003 and 2005. Donna's most recent exhibition, *Unconditional*, is on show at the Monash Gallery of Art between October 1st & November 20. Her imagery represents regional Australian children and adolescents—her own young family and friends— but it is also concerned with the peculiarities of the landscape near the artist's home: on one side, dense, box-ironbark forest, on the other, open granite country.

Carolyn Dew obtained her Bachelor of Fine Art and Postgraduate diploma of Fine Art at the Victorian College for the Arts. She is completing an MA in photography in the School of Visual arts and Design, La Trobe University. She has exhibited widely in Victoria and has just returned from presenting her work at an international conference at the Victoria and Albert Museum, London. Her images focus on the surfaces and decorative elements of her own home and she will discuss her work in the context of three other contemporary Australian artists who photograph domestic space: Annie Hogan, Angela Blakely and Glenn Sloggett.
